


Client Statistics for 2013 (Jan – Dec)

Client/Counselling Hours

We provided a total of 179 counselling hours 2013.

The counselling was provided in 3 Dublin locations and one location in Wicklow. The breakdown of hours per location are provided below. We have demands for extending our service to other areas but with current funding constraints are unable to do so. We hope to extend the availability of our service in 2014.

Client Hours by Location




Bereavement and Bereavement through Suicide

Bereavement by suicide is a worrying and increasing issue facing our clients.

- Over one third of clients were impacted by immediate family suicide.
- Over one third of clients are living in fear due to a family member's suicide ideation or previous attempted suicide.
- One fifth of clients lost their spouses to suicide.
- Over three quarter of all clients presenting with bereavement issues were bereaved through suicide.


Bereavement/Bereaved through Suicide 2013



Other Presenting and Emerging Issues

Other presenting and emerging issues are outlined below. Stress, Family Issues and Anxiety are the most prevalent issues arising for clients outside of bereavement and suicide.

Outcomes

The following outcomes were recorded for clients for 2013.

- Almost half of clients attending in 2013 continued to attend for counselling
- Of the remaining clients the following outcomes were recorded, and are presented in order of prevalence:-
 - Went into treatment for addiction
 - Finished Unexpectedly
 - o Unable to attend due to childcare or transport constraints
 - o Felt they got what they needed from the counselling
 - Left violent relationships
 - Were imprisoned
