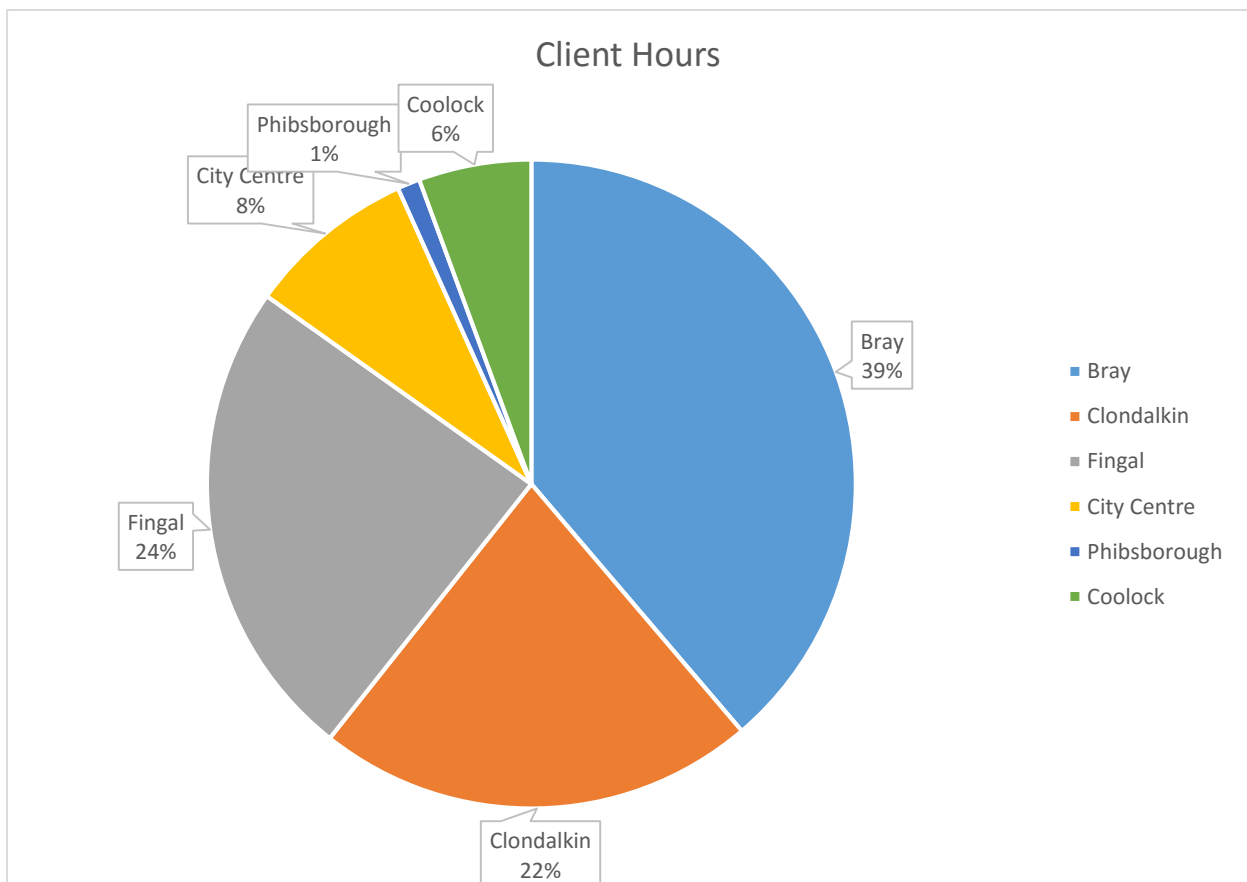
## Client Statistics for 2014

### Client/Counselling Hours

We have provided a total of 178 counselling hours during 2014

The counselling was provided in 4 Dublin locations and one location in Wicklow. We also started providing counselling in a 5<sup>th</sup> area in Dublin, (Clondalkin). The breakdown of hours per location are provided below.

### Client Hours by Location

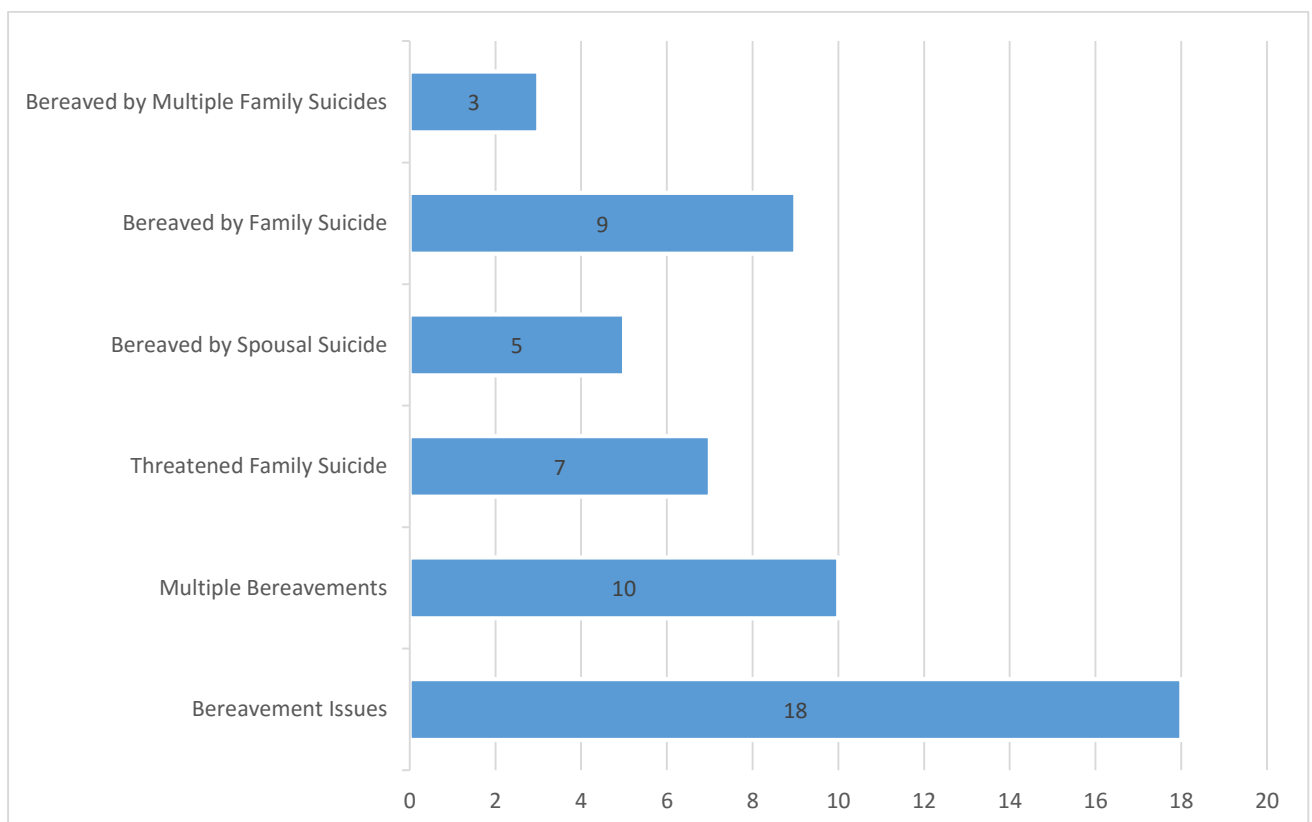


## Bereavement and Bereavement through Suicide 2014

Bereavement by suicide is one of the biggest issues facing clients attending our service.

- 72% of clients present with bereavement issues
- 40% of clients have experienced multiple family bereavements
- 36% of clients were impacted by family suicides
- 28% of all clients have a suicidal family member
- 20% of clients lost their spouses to suicide
- 12% of clients impacted by multiple family suicides

### Bereavement/Bereaved through Suicide

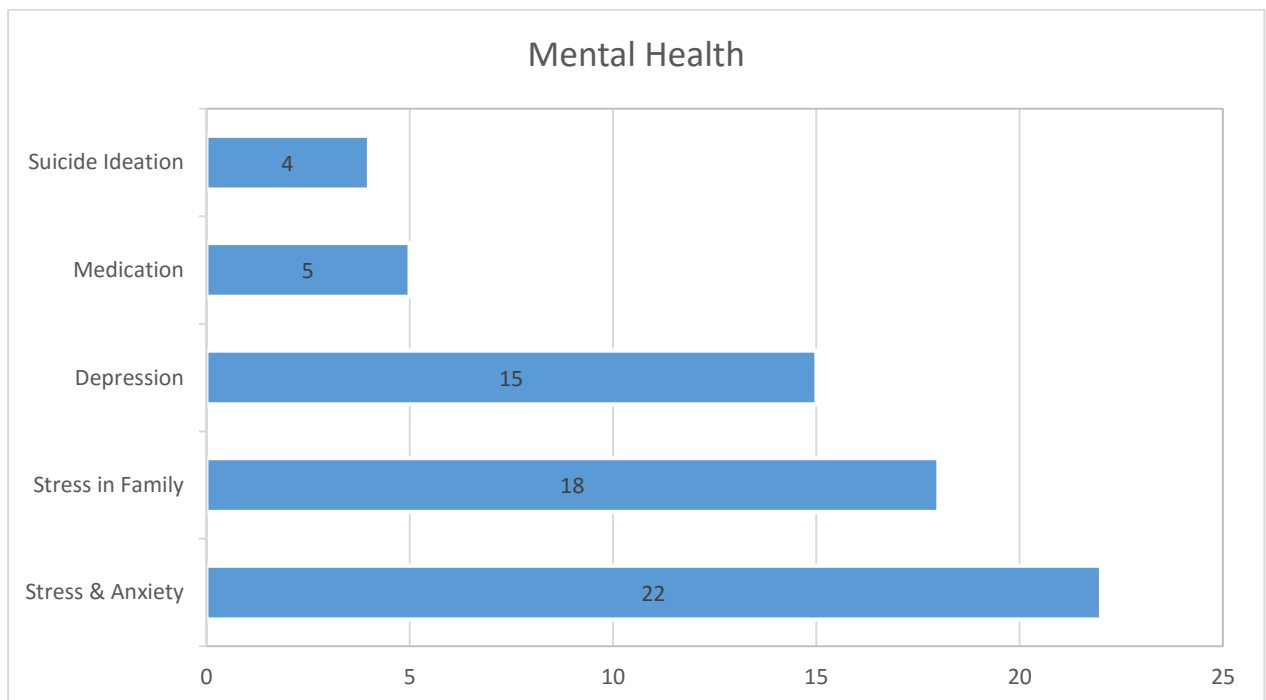


## Mental Health & Related Issues 2014

The majority of clients attending our service are struggling with their mental health.

- 20% of Clients using psychotropic/anti-depressant/sleeping tablets or similar prescription meds
- 60% of Clients suffering from depression
- 88% of Clients experiencing Stress and Anxiety
- 72% of Clients experiencing high levels of Stress within their Families

### Presenting and Emerging Issues 2014

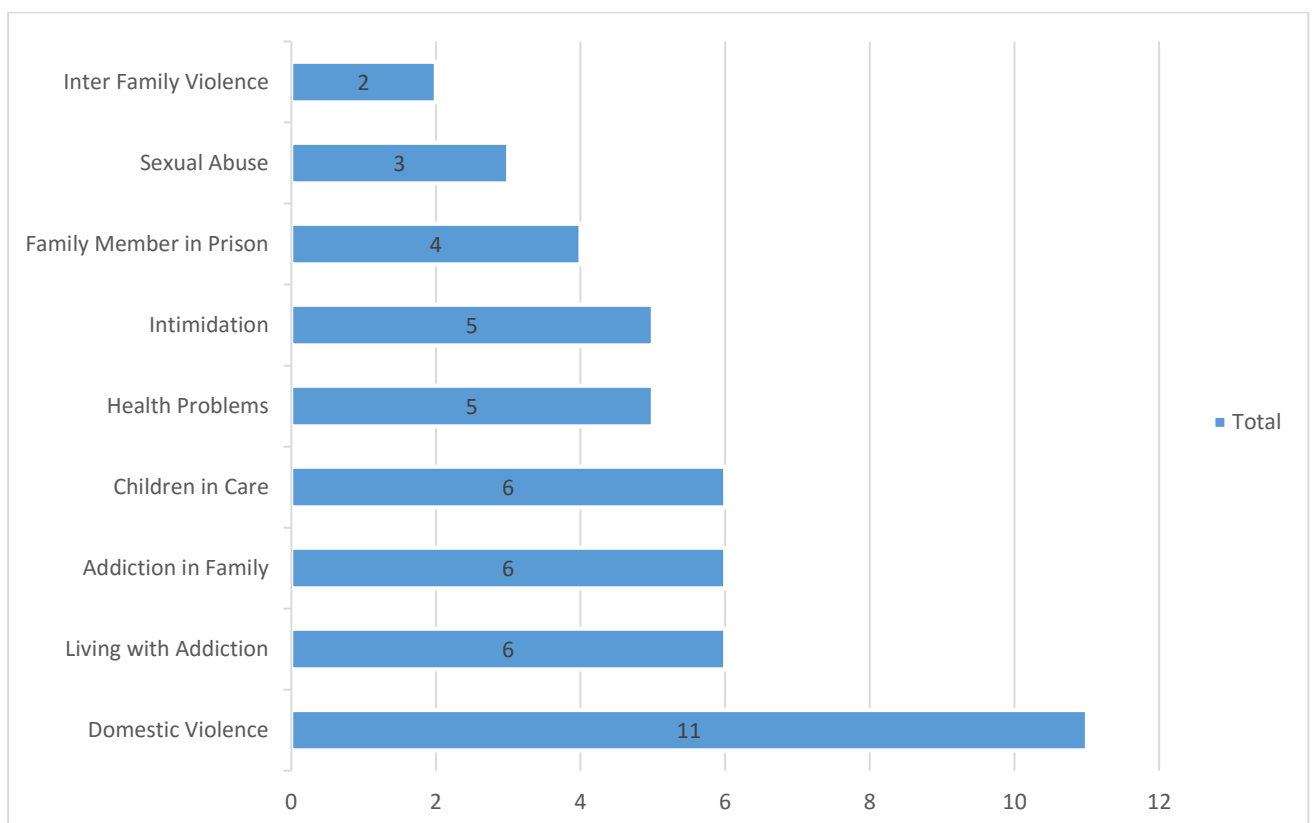


## Other Relevant Issues 2014

The following issues are presented in order of prevalence

- 44% Clients have been affected by domestic violence
- 24% Clients are living with addiction
- 24% Clients have family members impacted by addiction
- 20% Clients have children in care
- 20% Clients have health problems
- 20% Clients are experiencing intimidation
- 16% Have family member in prison
- 12% Clients are victims of sexual abuse
- 8% are impacted by inter family violence

## Outcomes 2014

The following outcomes were recorded for clients for 2014.

- 66% of clients who were attending at the start of 2014 are still attending for counselling
- 12% felt they had achieved what they wanted in counselling
- 8.5% of clients were referred on to specialised services
- 8.5% just stopped coming
- 4% were unable to attend because of childcare issues
